Founded in 1952, Norfolk Christian is a college-preparatory day school in Norfolk, Virginia. It is the oldest accredited PreK-12 Christian school in the Tidewater region and one of the premier Christian institutions in the country. The school serves students from all seven cities in the Hampton Roads area, as well as Virginia's Eastern Shore and northeastern North Carolina.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Norfolk Christian Schools operates on a semester system with four nine-week quarters over the course of a year. We utilize an A/B eight-block schedule where eight classes are taught over a two day (A/B Day) period, four blocks each day. **Mid-Year** grades are automatically sent to all colleges in January; **Final transcripts** will be sent to each student's final choice college in mid-June.
