## Job Description

The Middle School PE and Health Teacher will provide a welcoming and encouraging environment for all students to explore a healthy and active lifestyle, and understand the process of acquiring and improving fitness, nutrition, and appropriate health behaviors. He or she will aid students in the exploration of God's mandate to honor our bodies by implementing a daily regime of physical activities and health practices in the gym, weight room, and classroom, and will facilitate understanding and competencies within the core of the Physical Education/Health discipline.

As Strength and Conditioning Coach, he or she will monitor the progress of student-athletes both in season and out of season. The SC will provide guidance on weightlifting and conditioning progression for all student-athletes.
