General Requirements for All Students

- All clothing should fit appropriately with no off-the-shoulder or low cut shirts or sweaters, no exposed midriffs, no holes or fraying. Administration will have the final say regarding tight fitting or loose fitting attire.
- Outerwear (coats, hats, caps, hoods) may not be worn inside school buildings.
- Appropriate logos are permitted on shirts, sweatshirts, and hoodies.
 - Students must not wear or display the following images/symbols or words:
 - Images, words, or depictions of illegal drugs, alcohol, and paraphernalia are not allowed on school property or at school-sponsored events.
 - No vulgar, profane, or offensive language or images
 - Images/symbols or words that can reasonably be determined to incite violence or create harassment or discrimination.
 - **Administration will have the final say regarding logo appropriateness.**
- **Jeans/T-Shirt Fridays**
 - On Fridays, students may wear Jeans and T-shirts according to the guidelines above.
 - **Please see the first section. These rules still apply on Fridays.**
- **Dress-Down Days: These days will be determined by the Upper School Director**
 - Athletic shorts, jeans, sweatpants, and t-shirts are permitted. All clothing should still fit appropriately. Administration will have the final say regarding tight fitting or loose fitting attire.
 - **Pajama pants and leggings are not permitted at any time during the school year.**

Shirts: All shirts are required to have a collar.

- Any button down or polo shirt is permissible. Button down shirts must be buttoned enough to cover the undershirt.

Shorts/Pants/Skirts

- No leggings or legging material.
- No athletic shorts or pants are to be worn during the school day.
- **All shorts and skirts must be mid-thigh or longer**

Outer Layering

- Any sweater, blazer, sweatshirt, hoodie, or fleece is permissible. Appropriate logos are permitted.

Footwear

- Shoes may be open or closed toed.
 - Students who choose to wear Crocs must wear them in sports mode (strap down in the back).
- All shoes must have a back or strap.

Dress Code Discipline: Documented in NCSCConnect

- First Dress Code Violation: Written Warning
- Second Dress Code Violation: After School Detention (½ hour)
- Third Dress Code Violation: After School Detention (1 hour)
- Fourth Dress Code Violation: In-School Suspension
- Fifth Dress Code Violation: In-School Suspension
- Sixth Dress Code Violation: Out of School Suspension
- Seventh Dress Code Violation: Discipline Committee Dismissal discussion
