Job Title: Lower School Band and Strings Teacher

Campus: Lower School Campuses - Norfolk and Virginia Beach

Reports to: Director of Lower Schools, Lower Assistant Director and Fine Arts Director

Job Description

The Lower School Band and Strings Teacher is part of the Lower School faculty and Fine Arts Department. The teacher will carry out curriculum planned in collaboration with grade-level partners, the Director of Curriculum and Instruction, and other instructional specialists such as the Upper School Band Director and Fine Arts Team, to be approved by the Lower School Director and Campus Assistant Director. The Lower School Band and Strings Teacher will be responsible for planning and teaching lessons on a variety of band and strings instruments, including flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, trumpet, trombone, percussion, violin, viola, and cello to 1st and 2nd year players. Expectations of a Christmas and Spring recital presentation will be included in the role.

Qualifications

- College graduate, preferably in Music Education with an emphasis on Instrumental Music.
- Experience with teaching beginning band students.
